PROBLEM

- Individuals are not disclosing their different abilities to employers as they feel they will be treated differently
- Many students with different abilities are unaware of the support many organizations offer
- Large stigma surrounding individuals with different abilities in the workplace

SOLUTION

- 3 day recruitment conference designed specifically for students with different abilities
- Students will have the ability to demonstrate transferable skills such as leadership, teamwork, reliability etc.
- Allows students to become more familiar with recruiters enabiling them to feel more comfortable to disclose their abilities and to get workplace support
- Demonstrates how organizations are willing and able to accomidate everyone
- Reduce stigma surrounding individuals with different abilities in the workplace


